#### **Old business:**

##### Tournament Updates

- Trophies – Scott will order 180 trophies for each day of the tournament. Trophies for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and Consolation.
- T-shirts – Dawn Rund has come up with two designs this year and several colors, they will be for sale at each location.
- Friday night set-up- All volunteers are to meet at the Middle School at 8pm. We will start there. We cannot get into the high school until after the varsity basketball game and wrestling meet. We need to take down the gymnastics equipment and set up the gym. We cannot get into Oak Ridge until after 9pm. We do not need to use Pine Meadow this year.
- Steve Mackenthun has reserved the gym times with Community Ed for Friday night and from 7am-7pm both Sat & Sun.
- Trent Herman will set up brackets – the girls' tournament is full, we still need one 7<sup>th</sup> grade boys' team. 5<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys currently have 6 teams, can work with that number or recruit two more teams at each of those grade levels.
- Coaches will be assigned locations and duties. They will need to contact team parents to fill slots. Assignments will be determined at the January 24<sup>th</sup> meeting.
- Time clocks – ideally we wanted to use high school players to run the score/time clocks, but it sounds like both the boys & girls teams have tournaments that day. It was suggested we contact confirmation students that need community service hours and/or assign 8<sup>th</sup> grade SAYBA teams to time clocks.

- Mick is trying to contact John Ross to see if small bleachers could be placed on the high school gym floor as an option instead of folding chairs. To be discussed at next meeting.
- Hats will not be ordered at this time for sale at the tournament.
- Concession coordinating will be shared by Curt & Joyce Sorenson (Saturday) and Brad Zapzalka (Sunday). Joyce is checking with Panera Bread on the possibility of serving wild rice soup this year. Taco-in-a-bag was also requested.
- Portable Time Clock – Pete will locate and make sure it is in working condition.
- Rules will remain the same as last year, with the exception of sudden death overtime being eliminated. Teams will continue to play two-minute overtimes until one team wins. It was recommended that we revise the zone play rules next year for the boy's teams.
- It was decided that a SAYBA parent would be able to offer Scrapbook-type picture frames for sale at the tournament. Anything to be sold at the tournament is to be reviewed by the organization and it is up to our discretion as to what will be allowed.

#### Practice Times

Questions were raised regarding availability of practice times and the frequency of 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade coaches requesting practice during school-ball seasons. Steve Mackenthun shared that the big-gym times are in high demand, but Oak Ridge and Pine Meadow have earlier practice times available if a smaller gym is adequate. The 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade coaches usually only schedule one practice per week during the school-ball season.
